

In 2019, Shigeo Toya presented Body of the Gaze in his solo exhibition at ShugoArts, which featured a group of nine sculptures embodying his sculptural philosophy: carving based on structures formed by the gaze. This is a significant work of art to talk about Toya' s art practice as he creates a space for the crossing gazes, sliced out of his sculptures by his chainsaw one flash at a time. We also included Double Reflected Body in which the artist was inspired by Shan shui, traditional Chinese painting.
